I understand there is no reasonable action or inaction to avoid these risks, or the risks of some other person acting in a negligent careless manner. Therefore, I willingly assume those risks of injury to myself (or my minor child) and to my property. I waive, release and in advance forgo my right to pursue any such claims, causes of actions or right to pursue civil damages against the Utah Reined Cow Horse Association, its, agents, volunteers, members, employees and/or cattle contractors whether for personal injury or for property damage including those alleged to have arisen out of negligent and/or grossly negligent act or omission. Further, I agree to indemnify and to hold harmless the Utah Reined Cow Horse Association, its agents, volunteers, members, and/or employees from any cost arising out of injury to myself (or my minor child) or to my property.

Class Notes

- Snaffle Bit Intermediate Open – **All horses entered in the intermediate division must enter the open division.** For those entered in ONLY the Open, ALL of their jackpot portion of the entry fee will stay in the open division. For those horses entered in both the open and intermediate, their jackpot portion of the entry fee will be split 2/3 to the open and 1/3 to the intermediate
 - Checks will not be issued without a Social Security # or Tax ID #
 - NO LATE ENTRIES will be taken without a LATE FEE after August 27th, 2008. Late Fee \$15.00.
 - **Contestants and Owners must be a current NRCHA and URCHA Member in classes approved by those Associations.** Please let the show secretary know if your membership is pending & provide one of the following: a temporary NRCHA Card, a copy of your membership application, or verification from the NRCHA. You will be fined \$50 for not having a current NRCHA membership before you show, by the URCHA and, also, by the NRCHA.
 - **A copy of horse's registration papers MUST accompany entry (a veterinarian description of horse's age will suffice in the case of a grade horse.)**
 - Hackamore and Bridle horses (except \$1500 Open/ Amateur Bridle) will be shown in the Herd, Reining and Fence.
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- \$1500 Open/Amateur Bridle & \$3500 Junior Horse Classes are not NRCHA approved classes, only IntRCHA approved classes. These classes are for riders who have not won more than \$1500/\$3500 (respectively) in Reined Cow Horse competition, as of 12/31/07.
 - Junior horses must be 5 years old or younger and be shown in either a hackamore or snaffle bit.
